**REQUEST FOR QUOTATION FOR ANNUAL FIRE HOSE TESTING**

1. HOPEWELL VALLEY FIRE DISTRICT'S COOPERATIVE PRICING SYSTEM

It is the intent of the Hopewell Township Fire District No. 1, as Lead Agency, to receive quotes for consideration by the Hopewell Valley Fire District's Cooperative Pricing System (Identifier: 209HVFDCPS) for the physical inspections, pressure tests, and to provide test documentation on fire hoses in accordance with the National Fire Protection Association 1962 Standard for the Care, Use, and Service Testing of Fire Hose Including Couplings and Nozzles, 2013 edition, (hereinafter known as, NFPA Standard), of the participating members of the Cooperative Pricing System, (Hopewell Township Fire District No. 1, Pennington Borough Fire District No. 1, and Hopewell Borough Fire District No. 1), hereinafter referred to as the CPS. Each vendor must indicate on the form if they desire to extend the pricing to the members of the Hopewell Valley Fire District's Cooperative Pricing System. 2. METHOD OF SUBMITTING QUOTES.

Hopewell Township Fire District No. 1 will not assume responsibility for quotes not received by Thursday, April 14, 2014 at 10:00 AM. Quotes may be sent by US mail, electronic mail (to [mmartin@hopewelltwfire.org](mailto:mmartin@hopewelltwfire.org)) or by hand delivery. Quoter shall confirm receipt.

3. PROPOSAL FORM

Each proposal must be submitted on the proposal form. An authorized officer, with the firm name and address included, must sign all proposals in ink. The vendor must indicate on the proposal if pricing will be extended to the members of the CPS. Any proposals which are incomplete, conditional, or obscure, or which contain conditions, not-called-for erasures, alterations or irregularities of any kind shall be rejected at the option of the Lead Agency. Once submitted, no quotation shall be withdrawn or modified for any reason whatsoever.

4. METHOD OF AWARDING CONTRACT

As the lead agency, Hopewell Township Fire District No. 1 shall award the cooperative contract establishing the contractual obligation regarding the specifications attached. Hopewell Township Fire District No. 1 and each member of the CPS shall place orders independently and the Hopewell Township Fire District No. 1 shall not be held responsible for any order or invoices

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other than that of the Hopewell Township Fire District No. 1. Only the quotation for the Lead Agency, Hopewell Township Fire District No. 1, will be considered in determining award of the contract. A Cooperative Contract shall be awarded to the lowest, responsible, responsive vendor (40A:11-6.1). Each member of the CPS has the option to purchase from the contract so designated by the Lead Agency.

5. CONTRACT PAYMENT

Payment will be made upon satisfactory completion of the terms of the contract and the purchase order being submitted by the contractor in accordance with the requirements and customer procedures of the Hopewell Township Fire District No. 1 and the respective participating members of the CPS. No members of the CPS shall be responsible for interest on any payment delayed for any reason. Payment terms are net 30.

6. QUANTITY

Quantities shown are estimated and the Hopewell Township Fire District No. 1 cannot guarantee quantity. Quantities indicated on the proposal sheet are estimates only and the Lead Agency and participating members of the CPS may or may not have actual need for those quantities. Hopewell Township Fire District No. 1 and the participating members of the CPS reserve the right to award the contract based on decreased quantities.

7. PRICES QUOTED

Pricing will be utilized for 2014 hose testing only. Hopewell Township Fire District No. 1 and participating members of the CPS are exempt from any State sales tax or Federal excise tax. All prices are to be net, including any charges for packing, unpacking, transportation, etc. The quote given for each foot of hose shall be printed in ink or typed, in both words and figures, together with the total extended price. In case of errors or discrepancies between the price written in words and that given in figures, the price written in words shall govern in the computation of the quote. In the case of any error in extension, the unit price shall be considered as the quote. Failure to comply with the provisions of this section may be deemed sufficient ground for rejection of the price quote.

8. INSURANCE

The District will require the successful vendor to provide evidence that he/she has adequate insurance coverage: worker's compensation, public liability, automobile liability, and property damage insurance, and where required, certificates of insurance verifying the same.

9. SAVE HARMLESS CLAUSE

The vendor, if awarded the contract, agrees to protect, defend and save harmless Hopewell Township Fire District No. 1 and its CPS members against any damage for payment for the use of any patented material process, article, or device that may enter into the manufacture,

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construction, or form a part of the work covered by either order or contract, and he/she further agrees to indemnify and save harmless Hopewell Township Fire District No. 1, Pennington Borough Fire District No. 1, and Hopewell Borough Fire District No. 1 from suits or actions of every nature and description brought against it, for, or on account of any injuries or damages received or sustained by any party of parties by, or from any of the acts of the contractor, his/her servants, or agents.

10. NJ BUSINESS CERTIFICATE

All vendors shall submit a New Jersey Business Registration Certificate.

11. SPECIFICATIONS

The successful vendor agrees to conduct the physical inspections, pressure tests, and to provide test documentation on the fire hoses in accordance with the National Fire Protection Association 1962 Standard for the Care, Use, and Service Testing of Fire Hose Including Couplings and Nozzles, 2013 edition, (hereinafter known as, NFPA Standard), of the participating members of the Cooperative Pricing System, (Hopewell Township Fire District No. 1, Pennington Borough Fire District No. 1, and Hopewell Borough Fire District No. 1), hereinafter referred to as the CPS. Each vendor must indicate on the form if they desire to extend the pricing to the members of the Hopewell Valley Fire District's Cooperative Pricing System.

1. Conduct a physical inspection, prior to pressure testing, as specified in Section 4.6 of NFPA Standard. All hoses failing physical inspection shall be tagged and removed from service, without being pressure tested. CPS shall determine whether to repair and re-test hoses failing physical inspection. Vendor to provide pricing for repair and subsequent re-testing of hose, as needed.
2. Conduct service pressure test in accordance with Chapter 7 of NFPA Standard. Service test pressure will be as specified in 7.1 of NFPA Standard. The successful vendor shall not test any hoses higher than 400 psi.
3. The successful vendor shall deliver to Department final test documentation within 30 days of completion of testing. Documentation provided electronically, to include date of test, service test pressure, diameter, length, identification, test results as to each length of hose and a hard copy of summary reports for all hoses. Said report shall be on Microsoft Word and/or Excel.
4. The successful vendor shall utilize a stenciled number system with identifying station # and/or initials of fire company on hose, shall check all couplings for proper amount of lubrication, (and lubricate, as needed), and shall check and replace all gaskets as needed.
5. Any hose that fails to meet Standard requirements shall be tagged as such and removed from service by the successful vendor. If available, equivalent hose from the CPS station is to be used to replace any failed sections of hose removed from apparatus.

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- 6. The successful vendor shall provide all equipment required, including hydrostatic equipment, to perform CPS's hose test.
- 7. CPS members shall provide a suitable location for performance of the service test. The location shall include a water source for the successful vendor's equipment, and electric power/generator shall be provided by the successful vendor.
- 8. CPS shall make available to the successful vendor all hoses to be tested at the time and place established for the conduct of the service testing procedures and shall disclose to the successful vendor any known defects or dangerous conditions therein.
- 9. With the exception of rolled hose kept in the station, hose will be on fire apparatus, and the successful vendor will offload untested hose, and reload apparatus in department configuration with tested hose.
- 10. The successful vendor will assemble any specialty hose packs (e.g. high rise packs) following testing.
- 11. The service test to be conducted at an agreed-upon date, but in no case later than March 31, 2015.
